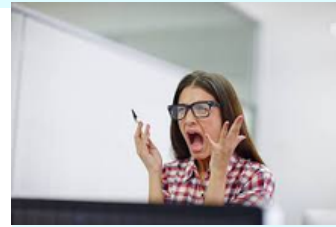

bad-tempered	Someone who is _____ behaves in a proud, unpleasant way towards other people because they believe that they are more important than others
considerate	Someone who is _____ is very careful to do their work properly, putting a lot of effort into their work
conscientious	Someone who is _____ is not very cheerful and gets angry easily
possessive	Someone who is _____ or who behaves in a stubborn way is determined to do what they want and is very unwilling to change their mind
loyal	Someone who is _____ pays attention to the needs, wishes, or feelings of other people
stubborn	Something or someone that is _____ is not yet completely grown or fully developed
impatient	If you are _____ about something that you own, you do not want other people to use them or you do not like sharing it with other people
unsociable	If you are _____, you are annoyed because you have to wait too long for something
immature	Someone who is _____ does not like talking to other people and tries to avoid meeting them
